In this context we have already successfully engaged in abolishing tuition fees and obligatory Latin language certificates for certain careers in the past years of our work. We also introduced the Semesterticket (providing free transportation in North-Rhine Westphalia) and the Kultursemesterticket (providing free entrance and discounts for cultural events in Münster).

- Improving funding and quality assurance in universities
